BC Nature Motion dated June 17, 2013

On June 17, 2013, BC Nature/Nature Canada filed a motion with the Panel requesting the following:

We respectfully request the Joint Review Panel to allow any party, at that party's request, the ability to participate remotely in real-time, including the ability to raise and speak to procedural objections, during the "Bottom Up" Oral Argument phase, or any portion thereof indicated by that party.


We respectfully request the Joint Review Panel to allow BC Nature and Nature Canada to participate remotely in real-time, including the ability to raise and speak to procedural objections, during the "Bottom Up" Oral Argument of Northern Gateway. 1

During the hearing this afternoon, the Panel invited parties to file their comments on the motion before midnight.

In principle, Northern Gateway does not take issue with remote participation and notes that all parties are able to listen to the live broadcast of the proceeding via the internet. However, the BC Nature motion and the submissions filed in support of that motion by other parties (such as Gitxaala and Haisla) seems to contemplate a process that would require the simultaneous remote participation of multiple parties.

If the Panel is unable to logistically accommodate that request and parties still feel that it is imperative that they be able to raise objections individually, then they should attend in person.
