Camp Latona	Active	Summer youth camp, capable of hosting 210 people overnight. Area includes 118 acres of forested land and 3500 feet of shoreline located on the north end of Gambier Island. Recreational activities include: canoeing, kayaking, rock climbing, boating, swimming, fishing, water skiing, wake boarding, and hiking (Camp Latona 2014).	3.2
Camp Potlach	Active	Youth summer camp and fall family camp located in north Howe Sound on 133 acres of forested area. Facilities include main lodge, 150-seat dining hall, ecology centre, 14 cabins. Recreational activities include: swimming, canoeing, kayaking and rock climbing (Camp Potlach 2014).	5.9
Daybreak Point Bible Camp	Active	Camp sessions run from late June to the middle of September. Nine of the sessions cater to youth aged 13 – 16, while two of the sessions are designed for college and career minded age groups. The area includes 96 acres located on the south end of Anvil Island. Camp facilities include a main lodge, 14 cabins, and dining hall. Recreational activities include: canoeing, kayaking, swimming, fishing, water skiing, wake boarding, and hiking (Daybreak Point Bible Camp 2014).	7.9
Camp Artaban	Closed for 2013	Youth summer camp located on Gambier Island. Facilities include dining hall, 16 cabins, which can accommodate 160, 16-bed retreat facility, 100-seat outdoor chapel. Recreational Activities include: sailing, canoeing, swimming, and hiking (Camp Artaban 2014).	9.6
Camp Fircom	Active	Adult year-round programs and summer camps (ages 7 – 18). Located on 65 acres on Gambier Island. Facilities include 6 cabins and 2 teepees to accommodate a maximum of 81, dining hall, 0.5 acre farm and orchard. Recreational Activities include: canoeing, hiking, kayaking, swimming (Camp Fircom 2014).	13.2
Camp Sunrise	Active	Run by the Salvation Army and dating back to 1925, Camp Sunrise is located adjacent to the Langdale Ferry	13.2

Camp Elphinstone	Active	Located on 144 acres along the waterfront located near Gibsons, YMCA Camp Elphinstone offers camping activities such as sailing and hiking for ages 5 to 17 (YMCA 2014).	15.2
