Subject: Pays Plat First Nation – Confidentiality Motion

Dear Suraj Dave,

On February 25, 2022 Pays Plat First Nation (PPFN) requested that the Report “Pays Plat First Nation’s Presence on Angler Creek – A Historical Summary” (Report) be kept confidential pursuant to section 2 of the Final Procedures for Requesting Confidentiality (CIAR #212). PPFN requested that the Report be kept private and confidential and viewed solely by the Joint Review Panel (Panel) (CIAR #1080).

In October 2012, PPFN also requested confidentiality for information submitted with respect to its traditional ecological knowledge and traditional land use studies (CIAR #288). In November 2012, PPFN clarified that it would be willing to share this information with the Joint Review Panel, named members of the Panel Secretariat, the proponent, and named individuals with the federal and provincial governments (CIAR #333). Can you clarify whether PPFN would be willing to share the Report with these parties?
