Summary of Comment

Permits are not required under the federal *Species at Risk Act* since, “Construction or operational activities that kill, harm, harass threatened/endangered species or damages/destroys their habitat”, will not occur on federal land in the context of this project.

The regulations under the *Migratory Birds Convention Act* do not provide for authorizations or permits for the incidental take (or disturbance) of migratory birds their nests or eggs in the course of industrial or other activities.

Proposed Action

Corrections should be made to the table “Summary of Permitting Requirements” regarding the *Species at Risk Act* and the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*.
