**Subject: Final Argument**

This letter is being sent further to the Panel's letters of November 7 and 14, 2018. Based upon communications from certain parties, it appears that there may still be some uncertainty or confusion regarding the process for closing arguments.

The Panel would like to make clear again that any party participating in oral closing argument is not to file a written closing argument/brief on December 5. However, those providing oral argument may submit to the Registry a script of their oral argument, which includes specific evidence references that are not provided during the oral presentation. There is no requirement to submit this document in advance of providing the oral argument.

Parties are not permitted to split their argument and provide partial written argument, submitted on December 5, and partial oral argument to be given on December 11. Parties must elect to provide either a written argument on December 5 or oral argument on December 11. To this end, if they have not already done so, parties must advise the Secretariat whether they will be providing written argument on December 5 or oral argument on December 11. If a party is planning to make oral argument on December 11, such party must advise the Secretariat in writing by no later than 4:00 pm MST on November 26, 2018 as to how much time they expect their oral argument will take.
