**Subject: Teck Resources Limited Frontier Oil Sands Mine Project – Final Argument**

On November 7, 2018 participants were advised by letter that the Panel intends to commence final arguments for the Frontier Oil Sands Mine Project Public Hearing in Calgary on December 11 at 9 a.m., and continue on December 12, 2018 as needed.

In response to the Panel's letter, you indicated that the Original Fort McMurray First Nation and Clearwater River Band 175 would present final arguments orally, in person, but that funding would be required to facilitate your participation.

I would like to remind you that neither the Panel nor the panel secretariat is involved in allocation of funding under the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency's Participant Funding Program.

However, I understand that the panel secretariat has provided you with a web link to [AER Directive 031](#): REDA Energy Cost Claims (Directive 031) for information on how to apply for funding from the Alberta Energy Regulator (AER). Note that a hearing participant may apply to the AER for an award of interim costs incurred in a proceeding in accordance with the scale of costs by completing an Application for an Award of Interim Costs form (see appendix C in Directive 031). Please see section 4 of Directive 031 for more information regarding interim cost awards.

If you intend to apply for funding from the AER under Directive 031, your application must be submitted 4:00pm MST on Monday, Dec 3, 2018.

If you choose not to apply for additional funding or are not able attend final argument in person, the Original Fort McMurray First Nation and Clearwater River Band 175 may submit final argument in writing on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 or present their argument orally to the Panel via teleconference on December 11 or 12<sup>th</sup>.
