I'm writing to confirm the details of our phone call yesterday afternoon.

We discussed the final arguments scheduled to take place in Calgary on Dec 11 and 12. During the conversation you confirmed that despite not receiving any additional funding to do so, Original Fort McMurray First Nation and Clearwater River Band will be attending in person to deliver closing argument orally. You also reminded me that during the hearing in Fort McMurray, Original Fort McMurray First Nation and Clearwater River Band explained to the Panel that moving the final arguments to Calgary would necessitate the provision of additional funds.

I reminded you that if, for whatever reason, attending in person is not possible that the secretariat will make arrangement for you to participate remotely via teleconference upon request.

We also discussed the fact that introducing new evidence is not permitted during closing arguments. You confirmed that in your opinion, none of the materials you planned to refer to are new, and that everything you wish to discuss is already on the record.
