Overview:

This addendum updates the "Guidelines for the Preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement for the Goliath Gold Project (the Project) pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012*" (EIS Guidelines), issued by the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency (the Agency).

These revisions to the EIS Guidelines are meant to reflect changes to the Agency's list of Indigenous groups with which the proponent is expected to engage for the environmental assessment based on new information made available to the Agency.
