**Project Name:** LNG Canada Export Terminal Project

**Proponent Name:** LNG Canada Development Inc.

**Inspection Date:** May 31 - June 1, 2023

### Project Description:

LNG Canada Development Inc. is constructing and will be operating a natural gas liquefaction facility and marine terminal for the export of liquefied natural gas (LNG) in the District of Kitimat, British Columbia. The proposed project would convert natural gas to LNG, approximately 26 million tonnes per annum, for export to global markets. The project is expected to have a life of at least 25 years.
