Braeden Connor:

On December 10, 2018, the Minister of Environment and Climate Change issued a Decision Statement for the Greenstone Mine Project (the Project) under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012*. The Decision Statement was amended and re-issued by the Minister on February 10, 2021 and February 28, 2025.

Following your submission to the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada on April 21, 2025, I am writing to inform you of my decision to update the Decision Statement. The updates will reflect the proposed expansion of the Project Development Area (PDA) to accommodate stability berms and seepage collection for the southwestern dam of the tailings management facility, and the updated trajectory of the access road to the T2 aggregate pit, as well as align federal and provincial annual reporting timelines. These changes are non-substantive updates, which do not require re-issuance of the Decision Statement by the Minister of Environment and Climate Change.

The enclosed updated Decision Statement will be posted on the Canadian Impact Assessment Registry.

It is Greenstone Gold Mines' responsibility to ensure that the activities carried out in accordance with the Decision Statement also comply with all other legal requirements of federal, provincial, or local governments.
