Janet Drysdale:

On January 21, 2021, the Minister of Environment and Climate Change issued a Decision Statement for the Milton Logistics Hub Project (the Project) under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012*. The Decision Statement was amended and re-issued by the Minister on July 26, 2022.

As per your January 6, 2025, submission to the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada, I am writing to inform you of my decision to update the Decision Statement to reflect the change in fuel source for switch heaters from propane to natural gas. These changes are non-substantive updates, which do not require re-issuance of the Decision Statement by the Minister of Environment and Climate Change.

The enclosed updated Decision Statement will be posted on the Canadian Impact Assessment Registry.

It is CN Rail's responsibility to ensure that the activities carried out in accordance with the Decision Statement also comply with all other legal requirements of federal, provincial, or local governments.
