**Re: Review of the Project Description for the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Rail Yard Project, proposed by Inter Pipeline Propylene Limited**

On July 16, 2018, the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency (the Agency) received a description of the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Rail Yard Project from Inter Pipeline Propylene Limited. Upon review of the information provided in your Project Description, the Agency has determined that the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Rail Yard Project is the same designated project listed in the *Regulations Designating Physical Activities* pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012* (CEAA 2012) as the North American Polypropylene Rail Yard Project that was previously subject to a screening under CEAA 2012.

The Agency notes that the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Rail Yard Project is proposed on the same site and has similar project components, design and capacity characteristics as the North American Polypropylene Rail Yard Project. The Agency is satisfied that the potential environmental effects of the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Rail Yard Project are the same as those anticipated for the North American Polypropylene Rail Yard Project. These environmental effects examined through the screening are well understood and there is little potential for the Project to cause adverse environmental effects on areas of federal jurisdiction as defined in CEAA 2012.

The Agency has determined that because the Heartland Petrochemical Complex Rail Yard Project is the same designated project as the North American Polypropylene Rail Yard Project, the Agency's decision issued on July 14, 2016 that no environmental assessment is required continues to apply.

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In proceeding with the Project, Inter Pipeline Propylene Limited may still be required to secure other federal regulatory permits, authorizations and/or licenses.

We thank you for continuing to work with Indigenous groups as part of your ongoing engagement efforts for the Project.
