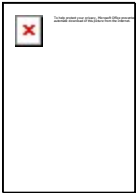

Thank you for your message. To clarify, does this mean that Pacific Future Energy Corp. intends to terminate the project?

Please note that IAAC can only terminate the environmental assessment of the project at the proponent's request. If you would like to terminate the project, please advise clearly in writing and we can initiate next steps on our end.

Alternatively, as explained in the letter dated July 16, 2024, if IAAC does not receive the Environmental Impact Statement for the Pacific Future Hydroelectric Project before June 20, 2025, the Project will likely be transitioned to the IAA and you would be charged for the work associated with that transition.

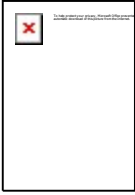
