SUBJECT: January 11, 2017 Designation under CEAA – request to terminate EA

Dear Ms. Parker;

In regards to the above-captioned prospective projects, and following the formal designation on January 11, 2018 by the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency (the Agency) of the projects for review under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act* (CEAA), the purpose of this letter is to advise the Agency of our intent to terminate the review.

As per section 62 of CEAA, we as the proponent hereby formally advise the Agency that we do not intend to carry out either the Sundog or Pelican RGS Projects (the designated projects). We request that the January 11 decision by the Agency to initiate environmental assessment activities be reversed and the respective environmental assessments be terminated immediately.

We wish to highlight that the decision by the Agency to designate the Sundog and Pelican RGS prospects under CEAA was a result of apparent administrative error by the Agency, rather than by Innergex Renewable Energy Inc. To the contrary, we held a conference call with provincial and federal agency representatives (attended by a representative of the Agency) on November 15, 2017 to communicate specifically that the two projects were not proceeding.
