## **Opportunity for public participation**

The Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (the Agency) is a federal body accountable to the Minister of Environment and Climate Change that delivers high quality impact assessments which contribute to informed decision-making on major projects in support of sustainable development.

Pursuant to the Impact Assessment Act, assessment of designated projects consisting of concrete activities governed by the Canadian Energy Regulator Act, such as the construction of an interprovincial natural gas pipeline, must be carried out through an integrated impact assessment conducted by a Review Panel. The Agency will work in collaboration with the Canada Energy Regulator throughout the integrated assessment process for the Gazoduq Project.

From January 30th to March 10th 2020, the Agency is inviting comments on the Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines and the Public Participation Plan. Comments will be documented and taken into consideration to inform the impact assessment process for this project.
