

## Notice of Determination

May 26, 2021 – Global Affairs Canada issued its Notice of Determination and determined that the project is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

### Notice of Determination

**Ottawa – May 26, 2021** – Global Affairs Canada has determined that the proposed provision of reliable water supply to three remote settlements in northern Pakistan is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

This determination was based on a consideration of the following factors:

- Community knowledge;
- Comments received from the public; and
- Technically and economically feasible mitigation measures.

Mitigation measures taken into account for this determination are:

- Sprinkling of water on extracted soil and proper cover with tarpaulin during the construction phase.
- Spreading of soil after construction.
- Proper installment (concrete) and cover of water intake chamber at water reservoir.

Global Affairs Canada is satisfied that that the carrying out of the project is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

Therefore, Global Affairs Canada may carry out the project, exercise any power, perform any duty or function, or provide financial assistance to enable the project to be carried out in whole or in part.
