## SUBJECT: Acknowledgement of Your Request to Designate the Proposed Erin Wastewater Treatment Plant Project under the *Impact Assessment Act*

Thank you for your letter dated February 25, 2021, on behalf of the Coalition for the West Credit River, concerning the Erin Wastewater Treatment Plant (the Project) proposed by the Town of Erin. You have requested that the Minister of Environment and Climate Change (the Minister) designate the Project under the *Impact Assessment Act* (IAA).

Under subsection 9(1) of the IAA, the Minister may, by order, designate a physical activity that is not prescribed in the *Physical Activities Regulations*. The Minister may do this, if, in the Minister's opinion, the physical activity may cause adverse effects within federal jurisdiction or adverse direct or incidental effects (resulting from federal decisions), or public concerns related to those effects warrant the designation. In accordance with subsection 9(4) of the IAA, the Minister is expected to respond to your request with reasons for their decision by May 26, 2021.

The Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (the Agency) will review information about the Project; any concerns expressed from the public (that the Agency is aware of) and Indigenous groups; and expert advice from federal authorities, provincial ministries, and municipalities in order to inform the Minister on whether the Project should be designated. If designated, to proceed with the Project, the Town of Erin would be required to submit an Initial Project Description, thereby commencing the planning phase of the IAA. In that case, the planning phase would include the Agency determining whether a federal impact assessment is required.
