

## **Notice of intent to make a determination**

### **Family Services Building – Public Comments Invited**

June 24, 2021 – Indigenous Services Canada must determine whether the proposed Family Services Building, located in Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg - Pic Mobert First Nation - 195 is likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects. To help inform this determination, Indigenous Services Canada is inviting comments from the public respecting that determination.

### **The Proposed Project**

The project will include all preparation and construction necessary for a Family Services Building.

Preparing of the site includes (1) clearing and grubbing (2) extending water lines, (3) preparing electrical connections, (4) building a foundation, (5) installing a septic system, and (6) placing of the modular units.

The modular units will be constructed offsite and delivered for installation following preparation of the site, the completed structure will be 3600 sq. ft. The lot is currently undeveloped and will be hooked up to the appropriate services. Development of the area will include a parking lot for the completed office.
