Upon receipt of the Detailed Project Description and response to the Summary of Issues from the Proponent, the Agency will review the documents and will decide whether to accept the documents within approximately 10 days. Please note that the Agency will post a notice on the Impact Assessment Registry and notify you when the Agency has accepted the Detailed Project Description and Proponent's response to the Summary of Issues.

The Detailed Project Description and the proponent's responses to the Summary of Issues will inform the Agency's determination of whether to require an impact assessment for the Project, and would inform the Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines, should an assessment be required.
