**Subject: Notification that the 180-day time limit for the Bruce C  
Nuclear Project is suspended**

Maury Burton:

The Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) acknowledges the receipt of your written request, received on January 15, 2025, to suspend the 180-day time limit to allow for additional engagement activities with the Saugeen Ojibway Nation. IAAC has suspended the 180-day time limit, which is the period of time within which the Agency must provide Bruce Power (the proponent) with a notice of the commencement of the impact assessment.

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When the prescribed activity is completed, which consists of Bruce Power providing IAAC with an update on engagement activities, the 180-day time limit will resume and IAAC will post a Notice of Resumption on the registry.
