Bruce C Impact Assessment: Resumption of Timeline for Planning Phase

The purpose of this letter is for Bruce Power to provide the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) with the following update on engagement activities with Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON). Bruce Power requests that with this update, IAAC will resume the 180-day time limit for the Planning Phase of the Bruce C Impact Assessment (IA).

As set out in Reference 1, Bruce Power previously requested a temporary pause to the 180-day time limit to the Planning Phase for the Bruce C IA to allow for additional engagement with SON. Further, as set out in Reference 2, IAAC will resume the timeline and issue a Notice of Resumption to the Registry upon receipt of this letter regarding the engagement activities.

Bruce Power utilized the pause in the Planning Phase to support further engagement with SON regarding the IA process and related field assessment activities. Bruce Power remains committed to ongoing engagement and collaboration with SON on the IA, including work to complete a renewed agreement between Bruce Power and SON that will outline key items, including, but not limited to:

- Areas of SON interest and concern related to the Bruce C Project,
- Manner and method of engagement between Bruce Power and SON (both collaborative and independent) to address areas of SON interest and concern related to the Bruce C Project,
- Establishment of bilateral working groups / task forces to support focused engagement on SON priority areas related to the Bruce C Project,
- SON's preferred approach for Bruce Power's involvement in community engagement; and
- Provision of capacity funding and resources to SON to support the above work.
