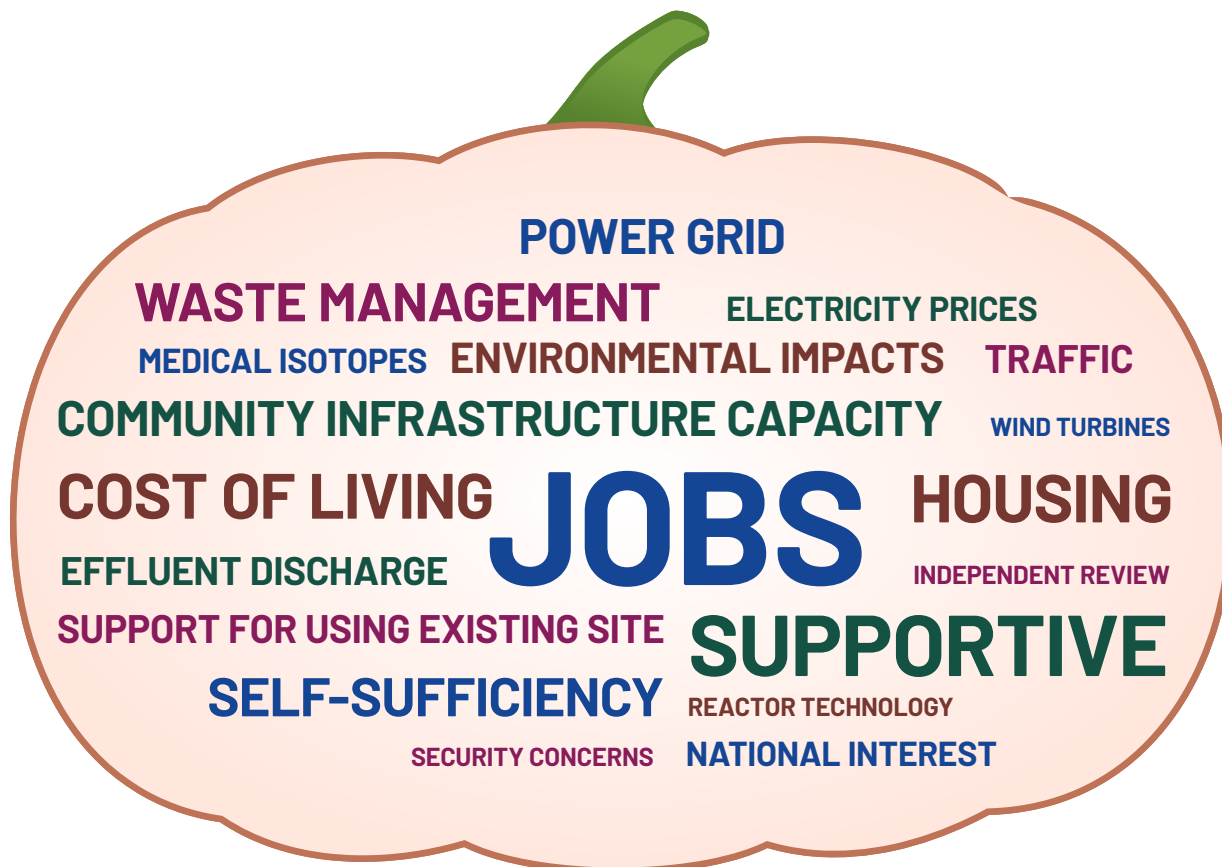


What We Heard Update Port Elgin Pumpkinfest Engagement
