## New Aircraft Engine Testing, Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul Facility located at Calgary International Airport – Public Comments Invited

**January 10, 2025** – The Calgary Airport Authority and Canada Infrastructure Bank must determine whether the proposed New Aircraft Engine Testing, Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul Facility located at Calgary International Airport is likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects. To help inform this determination, the authorities are inviting comments from the public respecting that determination. All comments received will be considered public and may be posted online.

## The Proposed Project

This project is for the redevelopment of approximately 3.15 ha at the corner of McCall Way and 78th Ave. NE at the Calgary International Airport to accommodate an aircraft engine test cell and maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) facility. The area is currently occupied by vacant industrial buildings. The development will consist of a building with areas for engine teardown, parts cleaning, testing, and reassembly, along with exterior paved areas for parking and logistics. In order to accommodate the proposed facility, the site will be fully remediated to commercial/industrial soil and groundwater guidelines. The Calgary Airport Authority will be funding, designing, and constructing the facility. The Canada Infrastructure Bank is also considering investing in the facility.
