Re: Request for a Regulatory Timeline Suspension for the Peace River Nuclear Power Project Impact Assessment Process

The purpose of this letter is to formally request a timeline suspension for the Planning Phase of the Peace River Nuclear Power Project Impact Assessment process (Agency File No: 005941; Registry No: 89430), pursuant to the *Impact Assessment Act*. Energy Alberta is requesting the suspension be effective as of 20 August 2025 and we anticipate the duration will extend for a period of three to six months.

The timeline suspension during the Planning Phase is in response to Indigenous Nations and Communities requests for a pause to allow for additional time to more fully and meaningfully participate in the process and increase community awareness and education related to the nuclear energy sector.

Energy Alberta has carefully considered the information provided by Indigenous Nations and Communities in their requests and would like to acknowledge the thoughtful and productive approach being taken in these submissions and in our ongoing engagement discussions. We will continue to work with Indigenous Nations and Communities to build mutually beneficial relationships, guided by respect, integrity, and a commitment to advancing reconciliation.
