Subject: Parks Canada review of Energy Alberta's comments on the federal recommendations for the Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines.

Dear Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC),

Parks Canada previously provided recommendations regarding the content to be included in the Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines (TISG) for the Peace River Nuclear Power Project in July, 2025 ([CIAR #332](#)). Parks Canada has reviewed Energy Alberta's comments on these recommendations, including those directed at Parks Canada. Energy Alberta's comments for Parks Canada relate to the organizational structure of the impact assessment. Parks Canada has no specific concerns related to Energy Alberta's comments for Parks Canada, provided the final TISG and Impact Assessment:

1. Consider ice jamming explicitly as part of the water quantity assessment but agree it does not need to be a separate valued component.
2. Ensure all information related to the Wood Buffalo National Park World Heritage Site is consolidated in a single, clearly identifiable section in the impact assessment.

As long as these elements are addressed, we have no further comments on Energy Alberta's remarks regarding our submission.
