

Construction of a Truck Access to the Grantech Site – Public Invited to Comment by December 13, 2025

13 November 2025 – The Montreal Port Authority (MPA) must determine whether the proposed project to construct a truck access to the Grantech site is likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

The Proposed Project

Grantech plans to build a new truck access road from the private access road to the Contrecœur Marine Terminal. This new entrance will serve the company's raw material storage site and will be located behind the Grantech plant at 1916 Marie-Victorin in Contrecœur, on federal land managed by the MPA (Montreal Port Authority).

This access will include separate entrance and exit lanes, each approximately 5.00 m wide, as well as two 600 mm diameter HDPE culverts to ensure continuity of drainage along the private access road to the Contrecœur Marine Terminal.
